Assessor's comment

John is a bright boy who has a diagnosis of dyslexia. His reading, writing and spelling skills have been noted by teachers to be below levels expected for his age and general ability, and this is confirmed by the tests, with all literacy measures except reading comprehension and typing speed below standard score 85. John tries to use his intelligence to compensate for his poor reading skills with the result that his reading comprehension score is within the average range. However, his reading speed is very slow and he has difficulty decoding new or unusual words, especially under conditions of time pressure as in examinations, which often causes him to misunderstand what the questions. His spelling and writing are particularly poor, with about 13% misspelled or undecipherable words. Although his handwriting speed is below average, his typing speed is in the average range for his age. It is recommended that John be permitted 25% extra time in examinations and also to use a word processor.
